Business survey

Overview of activities

53 local businesses were visited to provide information about the scheme.
43 local businesses were re-visited to advertise and conduct the survey.
7 businesses responded to the survey: **2** pubs, **1** supermarket,
1 salon, **2** cafes/restaurants, and **1** office-based business.

Suggestions for the Healthy Neighbourhood

- Introduce parklets for neighbours and hospital visitors to enjoy
- Provide e-bicycles with carts for local residents to borrow
- Consider the needs of disabled children who need to access the school street
- Reduce parking fees
- Provide support for dealing with difficult or disruptive customers
- Provide public toilets

Transport and access needs

- Businesses perceived that most customers use public transport or walk to visit the businesses
- Most staff members were reported to use public transport, walk or cycle to work
- 4 out of the 7 businesses reported having provision for staff bike parking.
