### Overview of activities



- Flyers providing information about the Have Your Say page and interactive map were distributed to **10,252** addresses on 12 March 2025

- **242 posts** were added by residents to the interactive map
- **29 people** joined the walk and talks
- **8 community groups** and **residents' associations** joined one-to-one meetings
- **53 businesses** were visited, and **7** responded to the business survey

### General Concerns

- Narrow, uneven and cluttered pavements are uncomfortable for pedestrians and make pavements inaccessible for people using mobility aides and prams
- Several of the streets connecting Kennington Ln and Kennington Rd are used as cut-throughs for motorised vehicles. Conflict occurs between drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians
- There is a lack of greenery and trees. Existing greenery is in need of maintenance at some locations
- There is a need for electric vehicle charge points, secure cycle parking and community spaces suitable and attractive for people of all ages
